The addresses above all resolve to the same server, if a person tries to access these connect points before the stream goes live, then the web cookies will be invalid for the live stream - meaning, they will get a request to log in. If this happens, the web browsers cache needs to be cleared of cookies before the stream can be accessed.

To avoid this we will start a 15 min countdown video before the event goes live-to-air in order to preempt any attempt to log in early!

For the stream on 7th April all authentication on the server will be removed, no logins or passwords will be required. Anonymous users will have guest access rights.
